All nominations must be provided in English and submit ed via the addition, they must include as supplementary material, a nomination let er, and at least two support let ers. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed or eligible for the award.

This Award honors Monte and Usha Ahuja, who enable internat onal students to study at Cleveland State University through the Ahuja Endowed Scholarship Fund and were internat onal students on their academic journeys. The award will be given each year to a graduate student who has demonstrated excellence in academic achievement and shown a commitment to campus and/or community engagement in fostering the internat onal learning experience. The Award is a recognit on of the outstanding contribut ons of internat onal students to the Cleveland State University community.

The recipient will also receive a cash award of \$250.

Nominees should be internat onal students who have distinguished themselves in various ways, including:

Academic excellence; minimum GPA requirement is 3.0.

Leadership or significant involvement in campus activities, international and cultural programs specifically.

Demonstrated commitment to celebrat ng and promot ng dif erent cultures, ident t es, and internat onal perspect ves.

Openness about their personal experiences and perspect ves in support of global understanding and inclusion within their community and feld of study

Leadership in fostering collaborat on and coalit on building between people and groups from internat onal backgrounds

Ability to use their own internat onal educat on experiences to empower their peers to enrich their global perspect ves and pursue internat onal learning opportunit es. Completed one semester at CSU and be enrolled full time.
