334495-02 Definitions.

(A) Child abuse

An "abused child"includes any child who:

- (1) Is the victim of sexual activitywhich includes children who are the victim ostatutory rape, sexual assault.
- (2) Is endangered as defined in sec22919.22of the Revised Code. A child is endangered if the person who is the parent, guardian,ustodian or is in loco parentis of a child creates a substantial risk to the health or safety of the child. Specific examples include child abuse, torture, excessive corporal punishmet that creates a substantial risk of serious physical herr or impairment to the child's mental health and encouraging, permitting or compelling a child to act, model or otherwise participate the production, presentation, dissemination or obscene, setty ariented material
- (3) Exhibits evidence of any physical or mental injury or death, inflicted other than by accidental means, or an injury or death which is at variance with the history given of it.
- (4) Because of the acts of his parents, guardian, or custodian, suffersphysical or mental injury that harms or threatens to harm the childs health or welfare.
- (5) Is subjected to outf-home care child abuse.
